Backpacks filled with items especially for children to help them cope with disaster and adjust to change

How Can You Help?

Get your group or organization to fill a backpack (either new or slightly used) with items that will help displaced kids as they head back to school and get on with their lives. Establish your drop-off / storage location— Relief International will pick up, ship & distribute them!

Suggested Kid-Kit Items:

A note / personal letter to child * Pens, pencils, crayons * Paper, notepads * coloring books
Sports bottles * Small toys * Small or light books * Compact games * Non-perishable food
Toothpaste / toothbrush * Comb or brush * Postcard from your home town
